Registration Information

Welcome to the Wilson High School Men's Lacrosse 2012 Season! We're looking forward to a great year, and welcome all new and returning players and coaches.

In Oregon, lacrosse is not an official sport of the Oregon School Activities Association (OSAA). Instead, lacrosse teams are run as non-profit clubs, which rely on fees and fundraising. Fees and fundraising this year will help cover coaches' stipends, OHSLA dues/referees, club insurance, field permits, equipment and maintenance, trainer and medical supplies, shorts for new players, bus transportation, website, etc.

For the 2012 season, Wilson HS Men's Lacrosse registration fees will remain unchanged from last year at \$425 per player. We are still having a hard time building up reserves in order to purchase new uniforms in the next year or two, but we don't feel we can further raise fees in this economic climate.

Player count is a key factor in our club finances. We expect about 30-35 players to turn out. If we could recruit 8-10 more players it's likely dues could be less. If you know of any interested players, please encourage them to turn out!

We recognize these continue to be challenging financial times for many families, and have taken the following steps in order to keep the cost as reasonable as possible:

- The total coaching expenditure will remain the same. (Note that our coaches' stipends are well below district scale for OSAA sanctioned sport coaches.)
- We will do our best to keep down the number and distance of away games, in order to save on buses and fuel.
- Once again we do not plan to replace any uniforms this year, so will continue to use uniforms on hand.
- We will again work with the Booster Club on the annual Christmas tree sales in order to maximize the funds we can potentially receive from them.

If you are interested in working on fundraising to help out club finances (such as working with the WHS Auction which in the past has raised around \$1000), please let us know!

We have some limited scholarship assistance available for players for whom registration fees represent a hardship. If interested, please contact Sarah Marin, Registrar, at 503-956-1506, or email smarin@zanthus.com.

To register, please do the following:

- Complete the **Player & Parent Information** form.
- Complete the **Medical Treatment Authorization** form.
- Complete the **Waiver & Release** form.
- Complete the **Player Code of Conduct** form.
- Complete the **Uniform Agreement**.
- Pay the uniform deposit (separate \$100 check, payable to Wilson HS Men's Lacrosse).
 - *Note: uniform checks will not be cashed. They will be held securely throughout the season, and will be destroyed once the player's uniform is returned washed and in good condition (see Uniform Agreement for details).*
- Pay the registration fee (checks only, payable to Wilson HS Men's Lacrosse).
 - Option 1: Single payment of \$425, sent in with registration forms and uniform deposit, no later than January 13, 2012.
 - Option 2: Two installments.
 - Payment 1: \$225 sent in with registration forms and uniform deposit, no later than January 13, 2012.
 - Payment 2: \$200, received no later than February 13, 2012 (two weeks prior to first practice on February 27).
 - *Notes:*
 - *Players will not be permitted to practice with the team until full payment has been received.*
 - *Final date for any refunds will be March 5 (the beginning of the second week of practice). Coaches choose teams and need to know which players they can count on going into the first matches.*

As a member of this team, the player agrees to abide by all OHSLA and Wilson High School Men's Lacrosse Team rules.

As a member of the team, participant agrees to:

- Compete intensely on the field, but always conduct themselves in a sportsmanlike manner.
- Represent themselves and their team, reflecting the highest standards of Lacrosse, their school and their team.
- Respect all officials, coaches, opponents, fans and teammates.
- Refrain from using profanity, taunting or illegal tactics.
- Conduct themselves according to the established rules of the game.
- Obey all rules set forth by the OHSLA, high school coaching staffs and/or tournament, clinic or event organizers.
- Abide by the attendance and minimum grade requirements as established by Wilson High School and Portland Public Schools regarding athletic eligibility.
- Refrain from using any alcohol or tobacco products.
- Remain free of all abusive or illegal drugs (marijuana, narcotics, steroids, Controlled Substances, etc.)
